Beyond The Poseidon Adventure A film review by Bob Hallock

When we last saw the SS Poseidon it was upside down in the editerranean and the French Coast Guard had just rescued the few sole survivors this disaster. As the Coast Guard helicopterflies away it is observed by Michael Caine, captain of the mighty salvage tug Jenny, his faithful companion Karl Malden, and the Flying Nun, who is along for the ride. They has lost their cargo in the previous night's storm so that a sinking ship's salvage was an opportunity to recoup their loss and save the Jenny from foreclosure by a mean French bank.

Shortly after they arrive at the Poseidon, a kindly doctor, played by Telly Savalas (?), arrives with several medical aides to assist with the survivors if there are any to be found. So back into the ship they all go, where they (you guessed it!) are trapped and must find their way out. Along the way they find several survivors: Slim Pickens, the rich Texan; Peter Boyle, the distraught father who won't leave without his daughter; Jack Warden, the blind man and his wife Shirley Knight and others.

The plot is very predictable as you have already guessed. Yes, Telly Savalas is not a doctor.

The special effects are poor, except for those from the original POSEIDON ADVENTURE. The opening storm scene, with the stage hand throwing buckets of water at Michael Caine was not believable at all. The movie was down hill from there.
