1. The Lincroft people will be discussing John Brunner's THE SHEEP LOOK UP and other catastrophes on October 9, noon. I rather suspect that Brunner doesn't think of his novel as being such a catastrophe, but the Lincroft discussion may be.

2. THE SHEEP LOOK UP, a novel by John Brunner, details the effects of ecological catastrophe as Mankind fouls the planet in the face of natural and man-made warnings. Although written in 1972, its occasionally extreme statements still have timely value. THE SHEEP LOOK UP is the main book for our October 9 theme of "Catastrophes *in* Science Fiction," not "Catastrophes *of* Science Fiction" as Evelyn implied in HOLMDEL THIS WEEK. Other books in this general theme are NERVES by Lester DelRey, LUCIFER'S HAMMER by Niven and Pournelle, and STAND ON ZANZIBAR, also by Brunner.

Speaking of catastrophes, the Lincroft chapter has run out of books on our agenda. If you show up at the meeting, you'll get to help us choose the next half-dozen books and themes. Plan to attend, and feel free to politic for your favorite books... [-jrtr, a.k.a. rob mitchell]
